

Precautionary Measures for Students Regarding the Novel Coronavirus 2019 (2019 nCoV)

Following Mapua University's Precautionary Measures regarding the Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCov), and in order to help control the spread of 2019-nCov, **Malayan Colleges Laguna – A Mapua School** is currently implementing the following measures as **classes and academic services are ongoing**:

- MCL strongly discourages its students, employees and faculty members from traveling to any area where other confirmed cases or persons under investigation have been identified (pending further notice from MCL);
- A student who travelled to a high-risk area such as China, Hong Kong, and Macao, or to any other country with confirmed cases of 2019-nCov or persons under investigation (for possible infection with said virus) such as Singapore, Japan, Republic of Korea, Australia, Malaysia, Vietnam, Thailand, USA, Germany, France, Canada, and the United Arab Emirates, shall undergo a 15-day self-quarantine upon arrival in the Philippines;
- While on self-quarantine, the concerned student shall be given make-up classes via **BlackBoard Learn®** to compensate for his/her missed class sessions between February 1 to 20, 2020;
- If the quarantine period goes within and beyond the Final Examination Period (i.e. from February 21 to 26, 2020), the student will also be given a special arrangement after the quarantine period;
- In 1-5 days after arrival, the student shall inform the Student Affairs Office about the recent travel and request for alternative learning activities via email (with attached passport and boarding pass):

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- The Student Affairs' Office (SAO) will coordinate with the concerned College/s about the arrangements for online classes;
- The student who may exhibit signs and symptoms during and after the quarantine period is encouraged to seek medical attention at any clinic or hospital that is accredited by the Department of Health and capable to handling these symptoms and cases;
- Upon completion of the quarantine period, the student is required to seek medical clearance from the CHSW;
- The CHSW will notify the Student Affairs Office (SAO) who will in turn inform the College/s that the student has been cleared.

The implementation of the abovementioned protocol is **final and executory** until further notice.

We are hoping for everyone's understanding and full cooperation on these measures as we put premium on the health and safety of the MCL community and the general public.
